Camargo: Some have made a profession of faith in Christ, but haven't continued coming to church.

I wrote last time of eighteen year old Paco being saved. He was excited to get baptized, and one of our ladies told his mom, to encourage her to come and see him baptized. She tore into Paco, forbidding him to be baptized! I told him because he still lives at home, to obey and pray for her, that she will understand and be saved. Pray for him to stay encouraged and for his family to be saved.

We baptized Joel and Lupita's 3 kids whom we had led to the Lord, so all the family are members! We also baptized Cristian, a teen who thought he was saved but just got saved.

I baptized Armando, who was saved, after one of his and Rebeca's newborn twin boys died.

While knocking doors, I went to a house I had been to before, but there wasn't any real repentance then. This time "Chapo" and Dora were anxious to know how to be saved!

Building: Thanks to the help of many of our supporters, we purchased the 10,000 sq. ft. building, which we are renovating, as long as we have money to continue. Most of our men, and several ladies, work 6 days a week, so aren't able to help much, so we have to hire much of it done. Because of things being so expensive, and all the things that need done, we'll not be able to put in ceramic tiles, nor ceilings, etc. in the auditorium and other places yet, but we trust the Lord will provide in His timing.

Don Primitivo, Alma's dad, came two days to work, with pick and shovel. He had never wanted anything to do with God, church, or the Gospel, but Meni, his 16 year old grandson has changed so much that he wants to help the people who are making a difference in his life! He said if Meni would stay faithful to the end of this school year, he would buy him a new suit. Pray he would be saved soon!

Family: On a recent trip to the United States to pick up some windows and doors that were donated for the church building, I got to go see all of my kids and grandbabies and also went to Men's Advance in Stillwater, OK! I needed all of it! I'm lonely, but I'm so busy I don't think about it a lot. It was hard leaving and getting back, but I needed to refocus, to serve with a renewed mind and vision.

Assistant: Ismael and Sarahí are doing well. It is good I can leave for a short time, leaving them in charge, that they learn, and for the church to learn to follow God's man, whoever he is! We have been praying the Lord of the harvest would raise up men, not so much for physical things, rather spiritual. It seems He is doing that with some of the teen boys that come over to help break concrete, clean, shovel fill dirt, etc. when they can, with a great attitude! Now several want to take the discipleship course! Strangely enough, we have about 10 really faithful teen boys and a couple of young ladies. Ismael and Sarahí deserve the credit for the difference we are seeing in the teens, as well as the positive impact on our church! They are a "God Send"! Pray they'll know the Lord's will for their lives!
